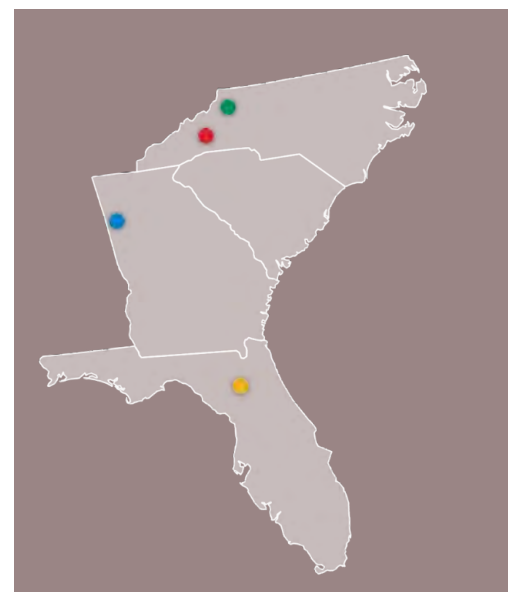

## DEPOSIT & PAYMENT

We accept the following payment forms: Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. Registration Office must receive payment in full at least 2 weeks before your arrival.

We require a \$150 deposit per program for each person. **These deposits are non-refundable and non-transferrable.** Your registration is not considered complete until NovusWay receives your paid deposit.

## MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT

Families with more than one child attending camp this summer are eligible for a sibling discount. After you register the first child at regular price all subsequent children will receive a \$35 discount. This discount only applies to children who live in the same household; it does not apply to any family camps or custom groups. This discount is applied automatically when you register. If you have any questions contact the registration office.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellation requests must be made in writing. Email to [registration@novusway.org](mailto:registration@novusway.org) or mail to NovusWay Ministries, 2049 Upper Laurel Dr, Arden, NC 28704.

Cancellations made 30 days, or more from the program date are eligible for a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit of \$150.

Cancellations made less than 30 days notice but more than 10 days are eligible for a refund of 1/2 the program cost minus the non-refundable deposit of \$150.

Cancellations made within 10 days or less do not qualify for a refund.

In the event of illness or extenuating circumstances, NovusWay registration may make additional allowances.

# Elementary

## NEW in 2023

You'll notice that we are ending 3 weeks of the summer on Friday afternoon instead of Saturday morning. We anticipate this move will be helpful for parents, campers, and our camp staff. 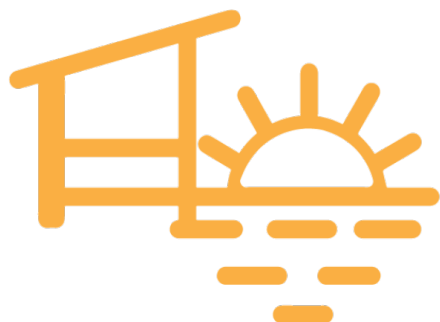

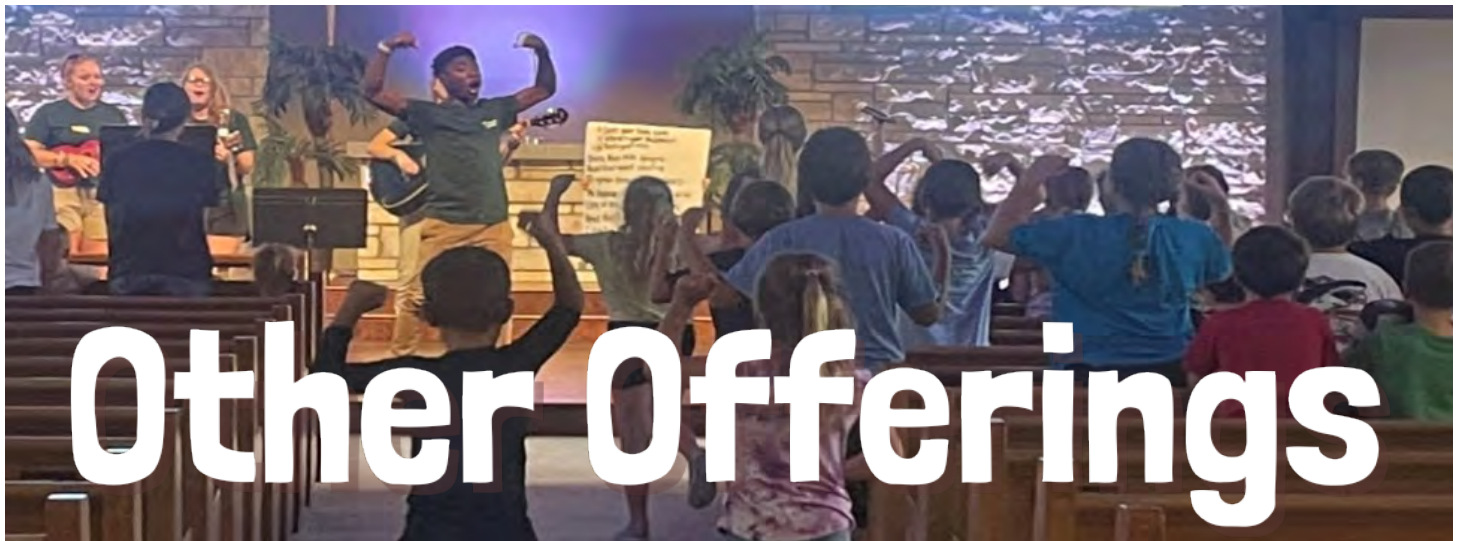
